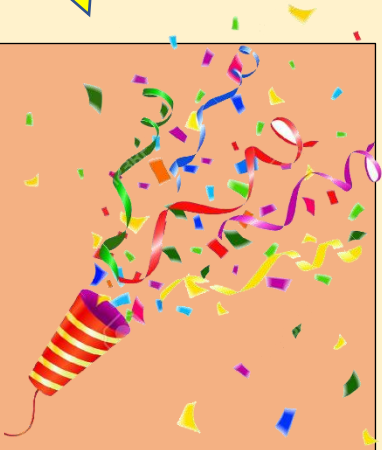

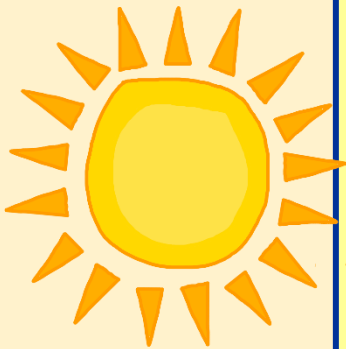


IMPORTANT REMINDER ABOUT NUTS IN SCHOOL

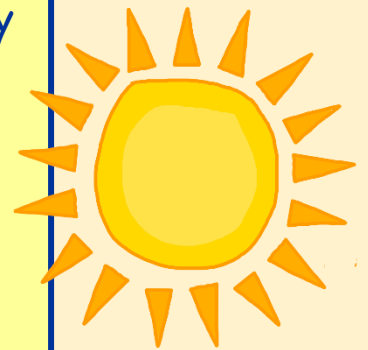
There are some children now in school with
